Interested candidates may apply along with the relevant documents. The application along with relevant documents must be submitted electronically to the Programme Leader Tandin Peljor via e-mail at (tandinpeljor.pce@rub.edu.bt) in pdf format before 04:00 PM on 19th October, 2020.

The college will provide the username and default password on 20th October 2020 upon the completion of the registration on 19th October 2020.

Enrolment Requirements

To be eligible for enrolment in this programme, the candidate should:

- I. Hold a bachelor's degree with a minimum of 50% aggregate from a university or an institution.
- II. Assurance of ability to pay tuition fees

The documents are required are:

- Copy of degree certificate (pdf format)
- Copy of degree mark sheet (pdf format)
- Citizenship identity card (pdf format)

The college will conduct the written and individual interview based on below mentioned criteria through VLE and ZOOM.

a. **Written Examination 70%**

All aspiring candidates must appear the **written examination on October 22, 2020 from 10 AM**. The writing time will be limited to ONE hour.

Candidates are required to write an essay on a given topic/situation in not more than 1000 words.

The assessment of essay will be broadly based on:

- i. Appropriate use of diction and syntax,
- ii. Use of relevant examples,
- iii. Clarity of language,
- iv. Coherence and logical presentation of ideas, and
- v. Effectiveness of communication.

b. **Individual Interview 30%:**

Candidates shortlisted after the written examination will be required to attend **Online Individual Interview** held via Zoom on **October 23, 2020 from 10 AM** onwards.

The outcomes of the selection interview will be made available in the college website on 26th October, 2020.
