	Eligible applicants will be merit ranked based on their academic achievements in Classes X and XII in the ratio of 30% to 70% respectively.

For Class XII graduates with the Rigzhung elective from other high schools:

The applicant will be merit ranked based on their achievements in Class X (30%) and Class XII (70%). Of these, a total of 140 applicants will be shortlisted for the face-to-face selection interview. The 140 shortlisted candidates will be comprised of a total of 84 applicants from the class 12 graduates with the *Language and Culture Studies Certificate* and a total of 56 applicants from among the applicants with the *Rigzhung* elective from other high schools.

The interview will test their academic proficiency (including English language and subjects contents), creativity, analytical skills, values, and character, aptitude and attitude to become a teacher.

Selection

The final selection of 70 candidates will be based on the following criteria.

- Academic performance in Class X: 12%
- Academic performance in Class XII: 28%
- Performance in the selection interview: 60%

The candidates will be merit ranked, and 42 seats will be filled by Class XII graduates with LCSC, while 28 seats will be filled by Class XII graduates with Rigzhung elective from other schools.
